Defendant VCE Commerce Solutions Inc.'s June 12, 2007 motions for the admission of S. Ashlie Beringer, Esq. and Scott P. Barlow, Esq. *pro hac vice* to appear as counsel for Defendant (doc. 91-92) are GRANTED on the condition that, within 15 days of the date of this Order, counsel register for electronic filing. S.D. Under the provisions of S.D. Ohio R. 83.5(d), “[a] motion for permission to appear *pro hac vice* shall be accompanied by a current certificate of good standing by the highest court of any state” While Ms. Beringer provides such a certificate from the highest court of Colorado, Mr. Barlow does not provide such certificate in this motion, instead only attaching letters from the custodians of the records of the Florida and California state bars. This is not a certificate of good standing from the highest court of either of these states. Thus, Mr. Barlow is DIRECTED to file a certificate of good standing from the Supreme Court of his state of bar admission **within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.**
