Dear Judge Frost

I am writing as a follow up to the status conference over which you presided in the above-referenced matter on August 29, 2007. During the status conference, you asked Plaintiff to notify the Court in writing as to whether Mr. Ferron has ever testified in his capacity as an attorney for a party in the litigation of a claim asserted under the Consumer Sales Practices Act ("CSPA").

After speaking with Mr. Ferron and reviewing our Firm's records, we believe that Mr. Ferron did so testify on only one occasion. At an August 17, 2006 hearing before Judge Sage in the Butler County Court of Common Pleas, Mr. Ferron testified in his capacity as an attorney for the plaintiffs in a hearing to determine the amount of attorney's fees and costs to be awarded to the plaintiffs under the CSPA. The caption of the case was *Nathaniel E. Burdge, et al. v. Kandassubs, Inc.*, Case No. 2005-11-3562. We do not now, nor have we ever had, a transcript of the hearing.
